



FIRE RELATED PRODUCT RECALL NOTIFICATION

Can-Am Commander Off Road Utility Vehicle	
22 December 2012	ACTION - New Zealand recall
Problem	BRP are recalling the Can-Am Commander side-by-side off road utility vehicle because of a potential fire hazard.
Details	A potential fire hazard can develop by driving through debris laden water (310mm or deeper). Debris build-up can ignite when heated and dried by the exhaust.
What to do	If you use your vehicle in these conditions, follow the cleaning procedure until your vehicle has been fitted with a "front grill kit" free of charge. Contact your authorised Can-Am dealer to arrange for the kit.
