27 March 2013 ACTION - New Zealand recall	
Problem	Mazda are recalling the all new Mazda 6 which has been on sale for just a few months worldwide as a precautionary measure after an incident in Australia.
Details	<p>The DC/DC converter which reduces current from the generator from 25V down to 12V may have a fault which could result in a fire.</p> <p>The converter is located under the front passengers seat.</p> <p>While a fire resulting from the fault is considered as unlikely, it is a possibility.</p> <p>Mazda will be contacting all owners of these vehicles.</p>
What to do	Check with your Mazda dealer or using your Vin number through the website below to see if your vehicle is part of this recall to arrange a repair free of charge.
