Welcome

The meeting opened with a karakia, and the Chair welcomed those in attendance.

Committee operations

The minutes of the previous Local Advisory Committee (Committee) meeting held on 21 November 2024 were confirmed. -The Committee also noted the correspondence received and updated the action log from the previous meeting.

Regional Public Service Commissioner

The Regional Public Service Commissioner discussed their role, current work programme, and environmental context across the region. This included the focus of work for the Public Service and connecting key stakeholders.- The Regional Commissioner also noted the ongoing coordination work of the Civil Defence governance group with long-term emergency response and cohesiveness of regional recovery.

The Chair thanked the Regional Commissioner for their presentation and discussion with members.

District update

The District Manager provided an update for the Nelson-Marlborough district, highlighting data on outputs over the last 12 months. -This included a review of fire season, recent operational events, community risk focus and staff survey results.

Draft District Plan

The District Manager provided a brief update on the Nelson-Marlborough District Plan and advised that recent emergency events in the South Island would result in the Te Ihu Region Leadership Team assessing its Region priorities, which will result in changes to the local District Plan. The Committee will be updated once the District Plan has been developed further by the quarter four meeting.

Region Manager update

The Committee welcomed the Region Manager to the meeting and members provided an overview of their background and interests.

The Region Manager outlined their initial observations of the region and its current strengths and challenges. They also provided an overview of their key objectives and deliverables and acknowledged the opportunity to develop a working relationship with the Committee and connect regularly.

National LAC Team update

The National LAC team provided an update on the work to establish four LACs in Waikato, Taranaki, Nelson-Tasman and Southland, as well as the upcoming Chairs' forum in Wellington on 12 April 2024, and key focus areas in working with the Marlborough LAC.

Insights Register review

Nic John updated the Committee on work undertaken by the committee sub-group on the review of the Insights register. -The Committee endorses the value of the work and implementing this into its practice and processes.

Stakeholder engagement planning

The LAC planned their engagement over the next quarter, as noted in the meeting actions.

Updates to the Board / insights

The LAC has worked over the last two quarters to strengthen its workplan as a much more active document and reflecting on its approach toward delivering quality insights for the Board. This has provided a period of reflection that the committee believes better focuses and directs its engagement for the District and identifies any capability areas for support.
